**FG International School**, established at the beginning of the academic year 2009-2010, has earned excellent acclaim among the educational circles in Jeddah. This English medium school which is designed for high quality education adds a unique silver lining to the academic horizon of Jeddah. The following lines will hopefully provide the reader with a near virtual tour of this distinctive institution.

### **(a) What is special with FG?**

FG is managed by a team of forward-looking educationalists with long experience in managing schools, organizing educational activities and involving in community development. The name 'Future

Generation' implies that the school cannot be categorized just as a 2G or 3G School.

Instead, FG will strive to be 'Future-G' with a slogan *Future in the making*, keeping itself at par with developments in the field of education from time to time.

### **(b) The very special facility**

Located in the Hai Al Faiha district (Old Airport) in the heart of Jeddah city with close proximity to King Abdulaziz University campus, FG has state-of-the-art facilities. It operates in a custom built building, with wide corridors and spacious classrooms.

#### **Classrooms**

Classrooms are colourfully decorated to suit children's mentality. Lower classes are provided with grouped seating to instill team work approach in children from an early age itself.

#### **Smartboards**

As part of utilizing modern equipment and methods in the field of teaching, FG employs electronic smartboards in every classroom. These are large touch sensitive boards at the disposal of the teacher. Teachers can interact with the board either in the traditional blackboard way or via its smart interface. Lessons are converted to Power-point slides and taught through the smartboard. Inclusion of pictures, animations and sounds helps maintain students' interest and makes learning more fun-filled. Contents of the board could be saved on the computer if required, in order to continue in a future session. They could also be printed or emailed directly from the board itself.

A built-in resource library contains huge collection of pictures categorized under different titles. These could be displayed on the board and explained to the students. Most geometric tools (virtual) like protractor and compass are also part of the smart features.

The smartboard makes the process of teaching and learning more productive and enjoyable.

#### **Networked Classrooms**

All the classroom computers at FG are networked. As the computer connected to a smartboard is part of the network, resources could be searched and downloaded from the internet as well as from the central server of the school. Internet can be browsed from the smartboard interface itself.

Student attendance records are also maintained on the classroom computer and could be accessed by the administration via the network.



## Mobile Computer Lab

Moving away from a traditional computer lab setup, FG utilizes a mobile computer lab. Modern laptop computers, housed in a mobile unit, move to the classrooms as required. The mobile unit comprises charging station for the laptops, network connections and a wireless internet access point. Students can attend IT classes from within the comfort of their own classrooms, and in their own seats!

## (c) Excellent Teachers

Qualified and well trained staff is our strength. A stringent selection process ensures that only the most talented are appointed. Their dedication to the profession and allegiance to the students demand that they keep updated, through a lifelong learning process. The frequent seminars and periodic discussions among the teachers, along with wide reading, enable them to achieve the objectives.

## (d) Transportation Facility

The school provides transport to any student residing in Jeddah who requires the facility. This facility includes brand new 30 seat buses that make the trips comfortable at reasonable rates.

## (e) The Classes/Curriculum

Admission is available to Playschool, Kindergarten (KG) and primary classes. The KG classes do not confine to a specifically named curriculum but adopts what is most suitable from different curricula. These classes follow the Montessori Method of teaching. The method is well known as an active learning process.

For primary classes, the school offers **British Curriculum**. However, materials are added to it as and when needed, thus giving it an international dimension and image.

Students are encouraged to work in groups in order to develop team spirit. The capabilities of students to make oral presentations are groomed properly and regularly, thanks to the electronic boards.

## Multiple Intelligences Theory (M I Theory)

FG plans to introduce M I Theory of Howard Gardner at a gradual pace in the teaching process. As part of this, the KG worksheets are prepared in such a way that most of the concepts in the sheets address several of the intelligences put forward by Gardner. This will help children having different kinds of intelligences to be treated and trained the way they deserve.

## Arts & Craft / Extra Curricular Activities

A fully featured activity room helps enhance the FG child's creative talents and learning ability.

Swimming is an essential skill of life. A kids' swimming pool is available for the students to learn swimming. Such activities are properly and thoroughly supervised. The pool water is filtered and disinfected routinely.

Karate training is offered on Thursdays. Games like Table tennis and Chess are also introduced.



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## Field Trips

The school organizes field trips on a regular basis several times a year to different destinations of interest to the students. Such trips are of prime importance to a child as what he observes in different production units, zoological gardens, science exhibitions etc. address his inquisitive mind. No doubt, children enjoy the fun involved a lot.



## (f) Arabic/Qur'an

The students who opt for Arabic language are taught by Arab teachers, in order to achieve maximum proficiency in the language. Students who opt to learn Qur'an recitation are taught by excellent Qarees (reciters).

## (g) Fee Structure

The fee structure is carefully tailored in such a way that the outstanding deliveries of the institution and the affordability of the parents go hand in hand. Consequently, it is neither too high nor too low. Payments may be made in instalments or in lump sum.
